Kuujuuaq, June 12, 2014 – Throughout the month of June, Elders' Month, the Nunavik Regional Board of Health and Social Services (NRBHSS) invites all *Nunavimmiut* to unite against elder abuse. Specifically dedicated to elders, the month of June includes World Elder Abuse Awareness Day on June 15.

On June 13, everyone is invited to tune into a regional radio broadcast on TNI (FM 94.1) between 9:00 and 11:00 a.m. Social media are joining in as well; for example, Facebook members can post a purple ribbon on their page. Also, the NRBHSS encourages the population and organizations to support and participate in the various local and regional activities that will be held throughout the month of June.
