Kuujuaq, May 31, 2019 – On May 28, 2019, the McGill University graduation ceremony was held in Montréal. Graduates Mary Iqiquq Tukalak, employee of the Inuulitsivik Health Centre (IHC), and Susan Nulukie, employee of the Nunavik Regional Board of Health and Social Services (NRBHSS), successfully completed their intensive training in management of health and social services.

The regional board's Executive Director, Minnie Grey, congratulated the graduates for their devotion and expressed her great pride in “all the work they accomplished within the Nunavik health and social services network. Their involvement represents a great contribution to improving the services offered to Inuit.” The regional board reiterates that training programs reserved for the personnel of the Nunavik health and social services network are available on a work-study basis.
